DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this label in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE IN HOUSEHOLDS, SCHOOLS, WAREHOUSES, OFFICE BUILDINGS, THEATERS, GARAGES, HOTELS, MOTELS AND KENNELS.

ATTACH EXTENSION TUBE TO SPRAY ACTUATOR;

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS AND CRICKETS: Spray on floors along baseboards in the kitchen and baths. Special attention should be paid to areas around refrigerators and entry points such as doors, windows, vents, pipes, etc.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS (mosquitoes, houseflies and gnats): Close space to be treated. Spray above head with a sweeping arm motion 3 feet from surfaces. Spray 10 grams (10 seconds) per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep treated areas closed for at least 30 minutes after spraying. Ventilate area before re-entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS AND SPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also, thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks and behind refrigerators.

TO KILL FLEES AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary.

DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS: Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also, treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
