Dear Mr. Quinlin:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

- 1. Under the DIRECTIONS FOR USE section, either delete all references to "Repeat as necessary" or indicate a time period for retreatment based on the residual efficacy of your product.
- 2. Where are the directions for attaching the extension tube to the spray actuator?
- 3. Please delete the statement "No unpleasant odor" from the claims made on the label. This is a subjective statement based upon the sensitivity of the user.
- 4. Revise the storage and disposal section of the label to be consistent with PR Notice 2001-6.
- 5. Correct the spelling of the word "FLEES".
- 6. Under "Do Not Spray Animals", add the following statement: "Also, treat your yard with a product registered for yard application."

Directions For Use

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Do not apply directly to food. In a Federally inspected meat and poultry plant, the facility must not be in operation when this product is used, regardless of the method of application. In non-Federally inspected facilities, careful spot and/or crack and crevice application may be used while the facility is in operation provided exposed food is covered or removed from the area being treated prior to application. Space sprays and general surface treatments may be used only when the facility is not in operation provided food has been covered or removed from the area being treated prior to application.

Cover or remove all food processing surfaces and/or handling equipment during application. Thoroughly wash all food processing surfaces before reuse. After application in bakeries, meat packing plants, food processing plants, cafeterias, and similar facilities wash all benches, shelving, equipment, etc. where exposed food will be handled with an effective cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse to remove all traces of contamination.

ATTACH EXTENSION TUBE TO SPRAY ACTUATOR AS FOLLOWS:

TO KILL COCKROACHES, ANTS AND CRICKETS: Spray on floors along baseboards in the kitchen and baths. Special attention should be paid to areas around refrigerators and entry points such as doors, windows, vents, pipes, etc.

TO KILL FLYING INSECTS (mosquitoes, houseflies and gnats): Close space to be treated. Spray above head with a sweeping arm motion 3 feet from surfaces. Spray (10 seconds) per 1000 cubic feet of space. Keep treated areas closed for at least 30 minutes after spraying. Ventilate area before re-entry. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL SOWBUGS, CENTIPEDES, SILVERFISH, FIREBRATS AND SIPIDERS: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also, thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these insects. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks and behind refrigerators.

TO KILL FLEES AND BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary.

DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS: Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also, treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

Precautionary Statements Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals CAUTION

May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.

First Aid

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.

Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If Inhaled: Move person to fresh air.

If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible.

Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing.

Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice.

Have a person sip a glass of water if able to swallow.

Do not induce vomiting.

Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.
