

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Note to User: This Deck Stain formula contains a mildewcide which is designed to resist mildew growth on the dried finish. This powerful mildewcide will not mildew-proof your home nor completely prevent or destroy mildew.

Deck Stain is for exterior use only and is recommended for shingles (not asbestos), shakes, clapboards, smooth or rough-cut wood siding, decks, porches, railings, outdoor furniture, structural support timbers, flat beds, cold frames and greenhouses. The product is not recommended for use on primed or previously painted surfaces nor for wood used for ground, food, feed or potable water contact. Cover desirable plants and shrubs to avoid possible injury. This product can be used where dairy and farm animals may come in contact with the treated wood.

Surface Preparation: For new decks, railings and other unfinished wood surfaces: the surface must be clean and free of mildew, greese, oil, dirt and loose particles. Test for mildew by applying a solution of household bleach and water to any discolored area; if the discoloration dissolves and rinses away. mildew is present and the entire area to be stained should be thoroughly washed and rinsed with a solution of one part household bleech and three parts water. Be certain to wear protective gloves and use caution in application as bleach can burn unprotected skin. Protect plant life around the structure. Rinse and repeat operation if all discoloration is not removed. Hose down the surface and allow all surface water to dry. Surface to be stained may be demp but not wet. New Treated Lumber: Pressure treated wood will not receive this stain until exposed for at least six months in exposed areas and twelve months in sheltered areas. Delay staining until penetration can occur. Previously Stained Surfaces: Remove all loose and peeling films. Scuff up areas adjacent to any bare traffic areas to enhance color uniformity. Select a color deeper tion the previous stain to enhance color uniformit. Test for mildew and treat as recomended above.

Color Selection: Different woods take stain differently. To ensure proper color selection it is recommended that a small sample area be stained before proceeding on the major area. Recoating previously stained areas requires a more opaque color and a more liberal application.

Applications Mix thoroughly by stirring with a peddle. Do not stake as this will cause bubbling. Stir occasionally during use or to keep color uniform. Avoid applying in direct hot sunlight or when rain may occur within twelve hours. On vertical siding start at the top with several boards and apply continuously to the bottom. On horizontal decks or siding start on one or two boards and apply continuously scross the surface or until a natural break in the board occurs. This minimizes the dangers of lapping. Apply a uniform cost with a synthetic brush, stain applicator or spray gun. Maintain a wet edge and apply product from the dry to wet, spreading uniformly.

Cleanup: Clean spills or splatters immediately with water. Clean tools with soap and warm water. Stubborn cil residue which has dried during the application may require a stronger solvent for removal. Thinning: Water reducible. Do not exceed one pint per gallon. Drying Time: Allow 24 hours' before foot traffic. Coverage: 150 to 300 square feet per gallon depending on texture and porosity of wood.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE:Do not store near excessive heat, or near food or feed products.
DISPOSAL:Do not reuse container.Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Guarantee: If, after proper application, MAXIM DECK STAIN FORMITA should crack, peel or blister, repi cement gallon will be furnished free of charge or a refund of the product cost made at the manufacturer's option. Cracking, peeling or blistering caused by a breakdown of a previous coating are not covered by this Guarantee.
