PHYSICIAN'S NOTE

If swallowed, use gastric lavage. Avoid aspiration. Toxaphene produces central nervous system excitation, which responds to barbituric acid derivatives. Prevent or control convulsions with barbiturates, preferably administered intravenously. If the barbiturate can be given before convulsions start, sodium pentobarbital is the drug of choice. Since toxaphene has a fairly long duration of action, a long-acting barbiturate such as phenobarbital may be used after initial control of convulsions. Refer to Clinical Handbook on Economic Poisons, which was prepared by the U.S. Department of Health, Education, and Welfare, Public Health Service, Communicable Disease Center, Atlanta, Ga.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs.
Toxic to fish, wildlife, and birds.
Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, or public waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance contact your regional office of the EPA.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use, pour, or store near heat or open flame.
If Toxaphene is spilled, use absorbent clay, hydrated lime, or other solids to soak up any liquid. Scrape up excess and bury residue away from water supplies. Wash area with a strong detergent and hot water.
