PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS (AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS) WARNING

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

May be fatal if taken internally.
Do not breathe vapors.
Do not get on skin or in eyes.
Can be absorbed through skin in dry form or in solution.
Keep clothing free from residue.

PHYSICIAN'S NOTE

If swallowed, use gastric lavage. Avoid aspiration. Toxaphene produces central nervous system excitation which responds to barbiturate derivatives. Prevention: control convulsions with barbiturates, preferably administered intravenously. If the barbiturate can be given before convulsions start, sodium pentobarbital is the drug of choice. Since toxaphene has a fairly long duration of action, a long acting barbiturate such as phenobarbital may be used after initial control of convulsions. Refer to Clinical Handbook on Economic Pesticides which was prepared by the U.S. Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Public Health Service, Communicable Disease Center, Atlanta, Ga.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Avoid contamination of food and feed crops.
Toxic to fish, wildlife, and birds.
Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.
Do not discharge into lakes, streams, ponds, rivers, or waters unless in accordance with an NPDES permit. For guidance contact your regional office of the EPA.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use, pour, or store near heat or open flame.
If Toxaphene is spilled, use absorbent material to contain it. Time or other solids to slur up and dispose of properly. Wash area and bury residue away from water. Clean spill area with a strong detergent and rinse well.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other approved state and local procedures.
