- 4. Dip (see below) or spray young pigs at weaning or before moving to fattening houses.
- 5. Isolate and spray any new or additional animals with the two initial treatments before mixing with the other animals.

Dip piglets (weaners) in a suitable size container. Dip 30 animals and then replace dip wash. Use dip wash to treat premises.

DO NOT apply to animals within 2 days of slaughter.
