#### REENTRY STATEMENT:

Do not enter treated areas for 24 hours unless protective clothing is worn.

Because certain states may require more restrictive reentry intervals for various crops treated with this product, consult your State Department of Agriculture for further information.

Written or oral warnings must be given to workers who are expected to be in a treated area or in an area about to be treated with this product. NOTE: CARZOL SP is not stable in alkaline water. Do not prepare the spray mixture until just before application. Do not prepare more spray mixture than will be used within 4 hours.

#### **USE PRECAUTIONS**

To avoid excessive residues, observe the following limitations:

- ☐ CITRUS: Do not apply more than 5 lbs. CARZOL SP per acre in a 12 month period.
  - Arizona and California: Allow 14 days between applications.
  - Florida and Texas: Allow 30 days between applications. NOTE: If brown soft scale is present in the grove, a suitable scallicide should be applied after the CARZOL SP application.
- ☐ APPLES, PEARS: Do not apply more than 4 lbs. CARZOL SP per acre in one crop season.
- PEACHES: Do not apply more than 2½ lbs. CARZOL SP per acre in one crop season.
- NECTARINES: Do not apply more than 4 lbs. CARZOL SP per acre in one crop season.
- PLUMS, PRUNES: Do not apply more than 3 lbs. CAR-ZOL SP per acre in one crop season.
- ALFALFA (Seed Crop Only): Use this product only on pure stands of alfalfa to be harvested for seed. Do not allow spray to drift onto adjacent crops. Do not spray while bees are visiting the treatment area. Do not allow livestock to graze treated fields. Do not use treated crops for livestock feed. Crop residues are not to be fed to livestock or baled for such use. Fields treated with CARZOL SP must be cleared after harvest by burning or by disking into the soil.
