GENERAL INFORMATION

The Amitraz Cattle Collar, when applied as directed, will prevent and/or control biting and sucking lice infesting dairy cattle. Amitraz cattle collars can be used on all ages of animals, all breeds, lactating and non-lactating. There is no withholding period for milk or meat.

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Directions For Use

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For prevention of biting and sucking lice, apply the collar in early winter (late November to early December) before pests are present. For the control of biting and sucking lice, apply the collar when lice are observed. Remove collar in the spring (March-April) after lice season is over.

Best results are obtained when the collar is used preventatively.

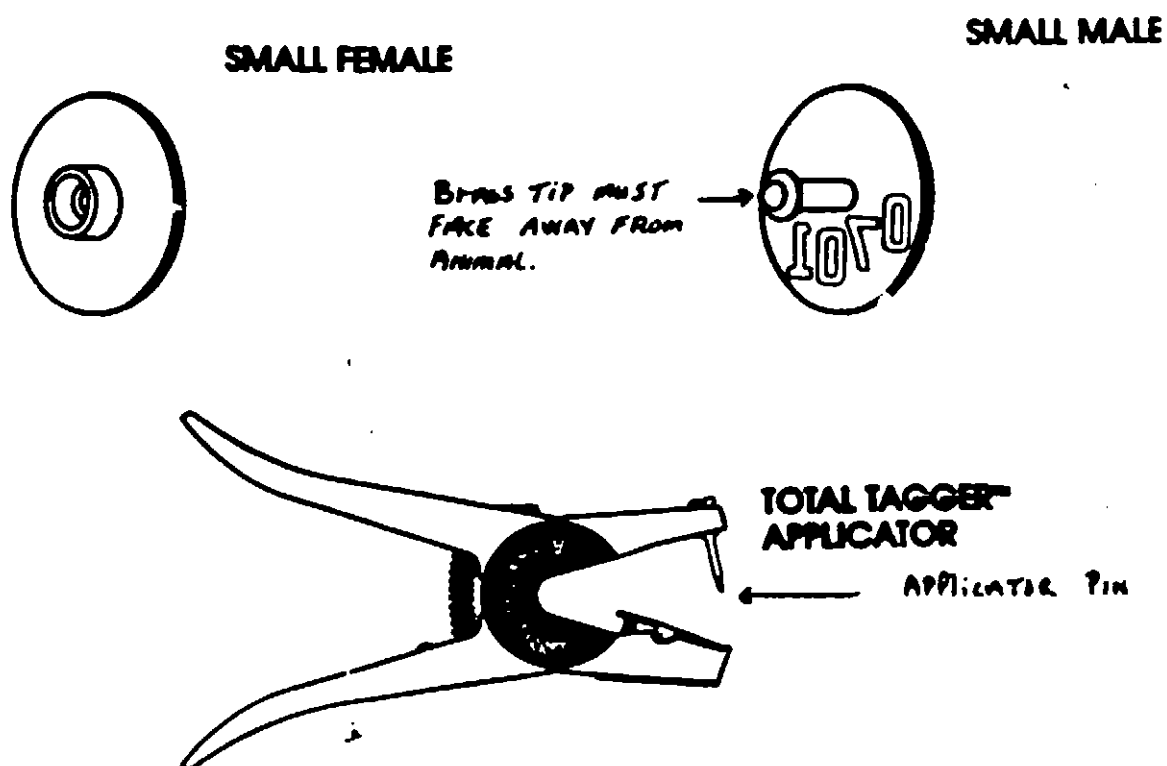
Apply one collar per animal. Attach the collar around the neck near the animal's head using the following directions:

1. Place the collar around the animal's neck with sufficient length for free movement, but not enough that the collar could be pulled off over the head. (As a guideline, the palm of your hand should be able to slide freely between the neck and the collar.)
2. Allow 2-3 inches overlap prior to trimming the collar length. This overlap is for attachment of the rivet closure device.
3. Using an Allflex®, Total Tagger™ applicator tool, position the male rivet section on the applicator pin; position the female rivet section opposite the pin.
4. Attach the rivet centered in the 2-3 inch overlap of the collar ends. The metal tip on the male section must face away from the neck. One rivet is sufficient to secure the collar.
5. Check the collar weekly on growing animals and loosen to maintain the free movement described in No. 1 above. If loosening is required, reattach a new rivet or re-use the previous one following the same procedures. Note: a rivet should not be reused unless it has been removed with a suitable tool specifically made for this purpose.
