DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Not for use on turf being grown for sale or other commercial use as sod, or for commercial seed production, or for research purposes. Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system. Keep unprotected persons out of treated areas until spray has dried.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer eliminates and prevents the growth of many weeds infesting lawns, turf areas and ornamental plantings in residential settings. Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer has a dual action: (1) it controls existing crabgrass and other grassy weeds in lawns and (2) it controls new weeds as they germinate without harming the lawn. Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer does not control existing broadleaf weeds.

Thorough coverage of existing grassy weeds will provide best results. Young, actively growing grassy weeds are more easily controlled than larger established grassy weeds. Visual symptoms of the annual grassy weeds are evident approximately 4-10 days after application (dependent upon weather conditions) but control of the grassy weeds will take 12-21 days.

The results of Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer are improved if the application is allowed to dry and then is followed by at least one-half inch of rainfall or its equivalent in sprinkler irrigation within 30 days. If this water management schedule is not followed, erratic weed control may result.

Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer may cause temporary coloration of sprayed surfaces. Rinse any inadvertently sprayed surfaces immediately to avoid staining.

WEED CONTROL IN LAWNS AND ORNAMENTAL BEDS AND PLANTINGS

Use in Turfgrass Species (Lawns, Sod, Turf Areas)

Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer can be applied for the control of existing grassy weeds and germinating grasses and weeds in a wide range of established lawns (turfgrasses). For best results, apply Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer uniformly to the problem areas in all varieties of the following turfgrass species: Kentucky bluegrass, perennial ryegrass, fine fescues, tall fescue and Zoysiagrass.

DO NOT apply to St. Augustinegrass, Bermudagrass, centipedegrass or any other turfgrass other than those listed above. Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer should only be applied to well established turfgrass.

Weed Control in Ornamental Beds and Plantings

Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer can be applied for the control of existing grassy weeds and germinating grasses and weeds in and among a wide range of established ornamental plants. Plant tolerance may vary according to environmental conditions. Determine tolerance prior to extensive use. Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer can be safely applied over-the-top of the following listed plants:

HOW TO USE

Apply Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer when crabgrass first appears. Mix 2 - 3 ounces in 2 gallons of water and apply uniformly to 1,000 square feet using a pump-up type sprayer. If fall reseeding or overseeding is planned, do not use this product after June 15th. Thorough coverage of existing grassy weeds is necessary for best results when using Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer. Young, actively growing grassy weeds are more easily controlled than larger established grassy weeds. Avoid applications to turfgrass under stress due to lack of moisture or temperature extremes.

Mixing and Applying

- 1. Use a hand-held pump-up type sprayer.
- 2. Fill the tank one-half to three-quarters full with clean water.
- 3. Add Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer slowly to the partially filled tank of water while agitating and then fill the remainder of the tank with water.
- 4. Agitate the tank sprayer occasionally while applying. If the spray mixture is allowed to settle for any period of time, thorough agitation is essential before spraying is resumed.
- 5. Thorough spray coverage is essential for best results.

Notes for Weed Control in Turfgrass

- 1. Stunting and/or chlorosis (yellowing) may occur on succulent, rapidly growing Kentucky bluegrass. These symptoms are temporary and will subside.
- Avoid application of Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer to turfgrass under stress due to lack of moisture, chemical injury or temperature extremes.
- Grassy weed control will be reduced if Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer is applied when
 the soil moisture is low and the annual grasses are under moisture stress. Irrigation prior to or within
 1 day after the application will improve annual grassy weed control performance.
- 4. The preventive (preemergence) activity of Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer will improve if the application is followed (after the spray has dried) by at least one-half inch of rainfall or its equivalent in sprinkler irrigation. If Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer is not activated by rainfall or irrigation within 30 days, erratic weed control may result.
- 5. In newly established turf areas, DO NOT apply Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer to seedling Kentucky bluegrass, fine fescue, tall fescue, or perennial ryegrass until the turfgrass has filled in and has been mowed at least four times. On turf that has been thinned or damaged due to winter injury, excessive moisture, etc., allow for turf recovery prior to making an application.
- 6. DO NOT use on annual bluegrass (Poa annua), or dichondra where these are desired lawns.
- 7. Delay fall overseeding by 3 months and sprigging by 5 months after application.

Notes for Weed Control in Ornamentals

- 1. Apply only to established ornamental plantings.
- 2. Avoid application of Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer to ornamentals under stress due to lack of moisture, or temperature extremes.
- 3. Stunting and/or chlorosis may occur on succulent, rapidly growing ornamentals. These symptoms are temporary and will subside.
- 4. Adequate soil moisture will enhance the performance of Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer. Thorough irrigation one to two days before or within one day after application will be helpful under drought conditions. Rainfall or irrigation within one hour of application or before spray deposit has dried may cause a reduction of grass control.
- 5. The preventive (preemergence) activity of Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer will improve if the application is followed by one-half inch of rainfall or its equivalent in sprinkler irrigation. If Preclaim Crabgrass Killer & Weed Preventer is not activated by rainfall or irrigation within 30 days, erratic weed control may result.
- 6. DO NOT tank mix this product with any other product for application on ornamentals.
