STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of skin contact, wash with plenty of soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. If product nets in the eyes, flush immediately with copious amounts of clean, cool water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately. If product is sucallowed, call a physician immediately. If patient is conscious, induce vomiting by stroking or tickling the patient's throat or far back on patient's ionique. Emetics such as 2 teaspoonsful (10 mL) of ipecac syrup or 1 teaspoonful (5 mL) of dry mustard in warm water to form a paste or even soap in warm water form be used. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Then have patient drink plenty of milk, gelatin solution, beaten egg whites, flour and water, or other nonoily demulcent. Never induce voniting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

ME 506 is used in cooling water by dension of a distriction washing systems to control microbiological sline. In cooling systems, add 4.7 to 14.2 ft. iz. of ME 506 per 1000 gall of water to the cooling tower song. In in washing systems, add 16.5 to 28.4 ft. oz. of ME 506 per 1000 gall of water to water conection trays. Repeat treatments every 1.5 cays or as needed. The required frequency depends or, relative amount of bleed and severity of slime problem.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited
