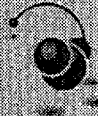

With respect to an unrelated question you have raised in recent correspondence to the Agency, please note that in the EPA letter dated 7/25/05 from Debbie Edwards, Director of the Special Review and Reregistration Division, which was also faxed to you that same day, the Agency stated that Taminco may resume sale or distribution of the three products listed above with use directions for application to strawberries. This has been the case since 7/25/05.

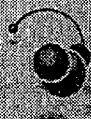
