

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Do not take alcohol immediately before or after exposure to this product. The consumption of alcohol by the applicator can increase the toxicity of the product. This product can cause skin itching, rashes and other dermal reactions to the user. Do not graze treated areas or feed clippings to livestock.

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PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

Some materials that are chemical-resistant to this product are listed below. If you want more options, follow the instructions for category C on an EPA chemical resistance selection chart.

Applicators and other handlers must wear: long sleeve shirt and long pants, chemical resistant gloves, (such as barrier laminate, butyl rubber ≥14 mils, nitrile rubber ≥14 mils, neoprene rubber ≥14 mils, polyvinyl chloride (PVC) ≥14 mils, or Viton ≥14 mils), protective eyewear and shoes with socks. For exposures in enclosed areas: a respirator with an organic vapor-removing cartridge with a pre-filter approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-23C), or a canister approved for pesticides (MSHA/NIOSH approval number prefix TC-14G), or a NIOSH approved respirator with an organic vapor (OV) cartridge or canister with any N, R, P or HE prefilter. ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present, or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not apply where conditions favor drift from treatment area. Drift and runoff from treated areas may be hazardous to aquatic organisms in neighboring areas.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Keep away from heat and open flame.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage, disposal or cleaning of equipment.

Storage: Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by use or storage. Store in original containers only in a secured area inaccessible to children and unauthorized persons. Absorb spills onto clay, sand or vermiculite and hold for proper disposal. Protect from excessive heat. Keep from freezing.

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GENERAL INFORMATION

BUCKBACK™ can be used to protect nursery stock, shrubs and ornamentals from rabbit, deer and rodent depredation. One application will protect treated parts from 1 to 3 months, depending upon weather conditions. This product can also be used a repellent in deterring deer from moving into unwanted areas as a result of local feeding and browsing. The addition of a latex based sticker prolongs the residual effectiveness of the treatment. Repellency is the result of rendering the treated plant parts distasteful. Some feeding may occur. As always, read and follow label directions for best results.

DEER, RABBIT AND RODENT REPELLENCY

Spray Applications: Growing Season

Add 1 quart BUCKBACK™ to 7 quarts of water and apply as a full coverage spray to all portions of the plant to be protected. Spray to runoff. For greater retention and residual efficacy add 1 pint of latex based sticker to the spray solution. Do not use wetting agents or surfactants as foliar damage may result. For best results spray when temperatures are greater than 40°F and relative humidity is less than 70 percent. Coverage depends on plant density.

Spray Application: Tree Trunks and Dormant Plants

Add 1 quart of BUCKBACK™ to 3 quarts of water and apply as a spray to all portions of the plant to be protected. Spray to runoff. For greater retention and residual efficacy add 1 pint of latex based sticker to the spray solution.

Brush On Application:

Add BUCKBACK™ undiluted with a paintbrush to stem parts and trunks to be protected. For greater retention and residual efficacy blend 4 fluid ounces of latex based sticker into 1 gal. of BUCKBACK™ prior to brushing.

Deer Repellency:

BUCKBACKTM is useful as a repellent for deterring deer from migrating into unwanted areas. It works by discouraging deer from localized feeding and browsing. The product is most effective when used in combination with mechanical deterrents such as ditches, fences, etc. Prepare and spray BUCKBACKTM exactly as for rabbit and rodent repellency (above), depending upon season and type of application desired. Spray to a height of 5 feet (1.5 meters).
