#### **DOSAGE RATES**

<u>EVERY THREE MONTHS:</u> 16 fl. oz. of SEAKLEAR ALGAE PREVENTION & REMOVER FOR POOLS per 10,000 gallons of pool water (or 500 ml per 40,000L) will prevent algae from growing in all pool types.

<u>SEVERE ALGAE TREATMENT:</u> 32 fl. oz. of SEAKLEAR ALGAE PREVENTION & REMOVER FOR POOLS per 10,000 gallons of pool water (or 1 L per 40,000 L).

#### **GENERAL DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Maintain pool water in the pH range 7.2 to 7.8. Total alkalinity 80 ppm to 120 ppm. Adjust pH to 7.2 for severe algae.
- 2. Ensure that filtration system is working properly.
- 3. Brush pool regularly.
- 4. Calculate the volume of SEAKLEAR ALGAE PREVENTION & REMOVER FOR POOLS required for the pool.
- 5. Add the product directly to pool deep end preferably in front of a water return. Dilute in a bucket of pool water when adding to pools with plaster finishes.

- 1. Clean all debris off of pool cover before removing. Remove and store cover.
- 2. Fill pool water to proper level, midpoint of skimmer opening. Remove any winter plugs, other winterizing equipment and verify there are no water or air leaks in the system.
- 3. Ensure all equipment is in proper working order. Check pump, filter and all valves and return lines.
- 4. Balance the water: pH should be 7.2 7.6; Total Alkalinity should be 80 -120 ppm. Brush entire pool surface.
- 5. Apply a chlorine-based pool shock or apply a chlorinating compound (not included) according to the product label instructions. If there is NO visible algae, turn on pump to start water moving through filter.
- If there IS visible algae, check with your professional pool dealer for additional steps to remove it.
- 6. Once pool is full and operational, add 32 fl oz of **SeaKlear Free & Klear** for up to 20,000 gallons. Operate pump and filter for 2 hours to disperse.


