2. Revise the statement of Practical Treatment to Read.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center.  
Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth and do not induce vomiting.


IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

#### CAUTION

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Shake bottle, lift spout, squeeze bottle to spray under appliances, sinks, furniture, around drains, along all sides of closet shelves, under shelf paper, on ledges; wherever roaches develop paths. Be sure to treat basements, attics and garages.

2. Tap a line of powder by holding bottle horizontally and gently tapping spout on surface to be treated. Put one line of powder in every drawer, around sides and backs of all cabinets and storage shelves, in cracks and crevices behind sinks and toilets. Also treat behind all office furniture and particularly in file drawers. One pound normally treats an average home of 2,000 square feet. New construction treatment in walls requires one pound for every 500 square feet.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

For best results, Ro•Pel® Roach Stoppers® should be used in every room of a building and applied in every place indicated.

Since Ro•Pel Roach Stoppers is non-repellent, roaches do not avoid it. When they get near it, the electro-static charged powder clings and is carried back to their nests.

Keep powder dry! If it gets wet, remove and re-apply, to guard against future infestation.
