The Agency is acknowledging receipt of your November 17 submission of a revised alternate Confidential Statement of Formula incorporating a blue dye to impart a dark or navy blue color to the final product. Your December 4, 1995 submission provided a revision of the labels submitted in your November 29, 1995 response to our letter of November 2 1995. Your December 11, 1995 letter enclosed revised labels restricting use of scatterbait. use sites to commercial establishments only.

- 2. Make the following label changes:
- a. From the label, delete the following implied safety claims, "A deep navy blue color has been added to reduce attractiveness to children," and "(FLYGONE contains a bitter denaturant to help prevent accidental ingestion by children, pets or domestic animals)."
- b. Change the HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS to "Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. Do not allow children or pets into treated areas."

If In Eyes - Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If on Skin - Wash affected areas with soap and water.

If Swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center. 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting."

- c. Relocate the "Avoid breathing dust" in the STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT to the HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS.
- d. Change the ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD statement to: "This product is toxic to birds. Collect, cover or incorporate granules spilled on soil surface. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes."
- e. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 45735-15."
- 3. Submit five (5) copies of the revised final printed label reflecting the above mentioned changes, before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.


