DISINFECTING

Hospital, Veterinary Clinics, Nursing Homes and Other Health-Care Units: Use 1 part of THIS PRODUCT per 22 parts water (5 1/2 oz. gal) for the 1/1000 cleaning and disinfecting of areas with light to medium soil loads. For heavily soiled areas, increase to 2 parts per gallon and then re-treat with THIS PRODUCT at 1 part to 31 parts water (4 oz. gal).

Schools, Industrial Areas, Barber Shops, Post-Office, Restaurants, Food and Meat Processing Plants, Non-food processing areas, Public Buildings, Other Non-Medical Units, Pre-tan Surfaces: Then finished with a solution of 1 part of THIS PRODUCT to 99 parts of water (2 1/2 oz. gal). Alternatively, clean and disinfect in one operation using 5 1/2 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water.

For disinfecting garbage cans, garbage trucks, industrial waste receptacles and garbage handling equipment, it is especially important to pre-clean the product to perform its job. Then apply a working concentration of 12 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water.

For routine general cleaning and disinfection of hospital disinfectant. Repeat treatment every seven days if when new growth appears.

THIS PRODUCT may be used through automatic floor scrubbing equipment.

THIS DISINFECTANT has not been tested for effectiveness against Mycobacterium tuberculosis and must not be used when tuberculous activity is intended.

THIS PRODUCT must not be used on food contact surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
