APPLICATION INFORMATION

Use the proper dilution of THIS PRODUCT for your use from the directions below. Add the solution into a clean, dry sprayer, pump sprayer, backpack, or other container or spray device.

Wet the surface to be treated. Do not make solutions. Do not use more than the amount listed below. Do not clean thoroughly all the surfaces to be treated. Do not use for at least 10 minutes to allow proper germicide action.

The product may be used for cleaning and disinfecting hard non-porous, non-metallic surfaces such as: sinks, tubs, pans, porcelain, enamel, chrome, stainless steel, plastic, fiberglass, and treated wood surfaces of walls, floors, appliances and furniture.

CLEANING

To clean and disinfect 10 to 15 square feet of surface, agitating in the solution, use 1/2 oz. of 12 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water.

DISINFECTING

HOSPITALS, Veterinary Clinics, Nursing Homes
Use 10 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per 12 gallons of water (1 part to 14 parts water) for one day cleaning and disinfection of areas with light to medium soil loads. For heavily soiled areas, pre-clean as described above and then disinfect with THIS PRODUCT at 5 oz. per gallon (1 part to 24 parts water).

INDUSTRIAL AREAS, BARBERSHOPS, RESTROOMS, RESTAURANTS, FOOD AND MEAT PROCESSING PLANTS, (non food processing areas), PUBLIC ROOMS, OTHER NON-MEDICAL USES

Pre-clean surfaces. Then disinfect with a solution of 4 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per 12 gallons of water (1 part to 30 parts water). After a day, clean and disinfect in the operation using 10 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per 12 gallons of water (1 part to 18 parts water).

FOR DEODORIZING GARBAGE CANS, GARBAGE TRUCKS, INDUSTRIAL WASTE RECEPTACLES, AND GARBAGE HANDLING EQUIPMENT

It is especially important to pre-clean for the product to perform properly. Then apply a wetting concentration of 18 oz. of THIS PRODUCT per gallon of water (1 part to 7 parts water).

FOR MOLD & MITE CONTROL

Follow directions for hospital disinfection. Repeat treatments every seven days or when new growth appears.

THIS PRODUCT may be used through automatic floor scrubbing equipment.

THIS PRODUCT must not be used on food contact surfaces.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

(For plastic and metal containers over one gallon)

Store only in tightly closed, original container in a secure area inaccessible to children. Do not concentrate waste, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Residual wastes are acutely hazardous. Proper disposal of excess pesticide spray mixture or residue is a violation of Federal law.
