On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby Registered/Reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

A copy of the labeling accepted in connection with this Registration/Reregistration is returned herewith.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an indorsement or approval of this product by this Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c) (7) (A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c) (5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 45869-1."
- b. In the Environmental Hazards section, following the statement, "This pesticide is toxic to fish," revise the rest of the paragraph to read as follows:

Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to

discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

3. Re-submit your Confidential Statement of Formula within 75 days, revised as indicated in the "Confidential Statement of Formula" enclosure.

4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

Note that a Reregistration Eligibility Decision (RED) document for Chlorine is expected to be published soon. New requirements may be set forth in that document.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Have available gas masks approved by the U.S. Bureau of Mines or the National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health. Handle and use only in accordance with practice recommended in the Chlorine Manual published by the Chlorine Institute Inc., New York. Use only in well ventilated areas.

"Only specifically designed dispensing equipment should be used in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and according to state regulatory agency recommendations for dosages or residual chlorine levels which should be maintained for each specific site of application."

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL** Keep containers away from heat. Do not store in direct sunlight. Do not drop containers. Empty cylinders should be properly identified with return tags and returned to the supplier according to prescribed instructions and practices by the supplier.
