DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Adjust water pH to 7.2-7.6 as determined by a test kit.
2. If the pool has not been previously stabilized, add conditioner and stabilizer (cyanuric acid). Follow the directions for use on the label for that product.
3. Place tablets in floating type chlorinator or in the pool skimmer.
4. Add two tablets per 5,000 gallons of pool water to establish a chlorine residual of 1.5 to 2.0 ppm as determined by a test kit. Add more tablets as needed.

Please note: The pH of the slow dissolving tablets is on the acid side and will tend to reduce the pH and alkalinity of the pool water. Proper pH should be maintained at pH 7.2 to 7.6 as determined by a test kit, by periodic additions of sodium carbonate or sodium bicarbonate.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container as far as possible and flood with large amounts of water. Do not re-seal empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash container or dispose in approved landfill area.

Heat generated may cause an explosion.
