**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

When adding this product to a skimmer, make sure pump, sump and water is circulating so that material is drawn into recirculation system. Do not allow build up of dry material in skimmer as gases generated may cause an explosion.

Please note: The pH of the slow dissolving tablets is on the acid side and will tend to reduce the pH and alkalinity of the pool water. Proper pH should be maintained at pH 7.2 to 7.6 as determined by a test kit, by periodic additions of sodium carbonate or sodium bicarbonate.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep product dry tightly sealed when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame in case of decomposition. Separate material from other materials if possible and flood with large amounts of water. Do not use empty containers for anything else. Do not mix with water or other materials before discarding. 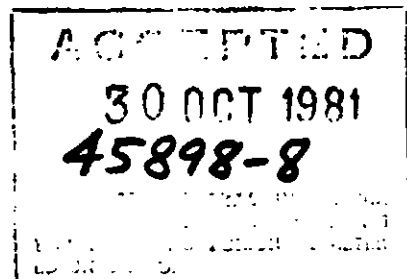

4. To maintain a chlorine residual of 1.0 ppm, add 1.0 tablets per 5000 gallons of water. Follow feeder directions carefully.

Please note: The pH of this product is acid and will tend to lower the pH of pool water. Proper pH should be maintained as determined by a test kit. Add sodium bicarbonate or sodium carbonate as needed.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep in a cool, dry place when not in use. Store in a cool, dry place or open flame. In case of decomposition, flood with large amount of water. Rinse empty container thoroughly before discarding. Dispose of in approved landfill area.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container in open area if possible, and flood with large amounts of water. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area
