

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

INITIAL CHLORINATION: For each gallon of any pool water, add 1/2 lb. for every 10,000 gallons. Allow 10 hours to pass and then test the water. If the chlorine level is below 2.0 ppm, repeat the chlorination. Repeat until the chlorine level is 2.0 ppm.

ROUTINE CHLORINATION DOSAGE: For every 10,000 gallons of water, add 1/2 lb. of chlorine granules every 10 days. If the water is cloudy, add 1/2 lb. of chlorine granules every 5 days. If the water is green, add 1/2 lb. of chlorine granules every 3 days. If the water is brown, add 1/2 lb. of chlorine granules every 2 days.

STABILIZED POOLS: If you have a stabilized pool, add 1/2 lb. of chlorine granules every 10 days. If the water is cloudy, add 1/2 lb. of chlorine granules every 5 days. If the water is green, add 1/2 lb. of chlorine granules every 3 days. If the water is brown, add 1/2 lb. of chlorine granules every 2 days.

MAINTENANCE OF pH: The pH of the water should be maintained between 7.2 and 7.8. If the pH is below 7.2, add 1/2 lb. of soda ash. If the pH is above 7.8, add 1/2 lb. of muriatic acid.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL: Keep product in original container. Do not use if container is damaged. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not use if the product is expired. Dispose of the product in accordance with local regulations.
