Submission dated August 8, 1994 requesting the removal of certain
precautionary statements

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes to your label:

1. The signal word and the warning for children should be on separate lines with the children's warning above the signal word. The proposed label, in which there is a colon after the signal word followed by the children's warning, implies that it is there only for children, rather than as the overall signal word for the product. The label should read as follows:

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

CAUTION

READ PRECAUTIONS AND DIRECTIONS ON BACK BEFORE USING

2. The proposed label contains the heading "Precautionary Statement:" on the back panel. This should be removed unless you choose to add Category III statements to this section. The storage and disposal statements are not considered to be precautionary statements.

3. Delete the words "insect-free" from the statement "Enjoy an insect-free barbecue or picnic..."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

INDOORS: Hold container upright 24 inches from surfaces, and spray away from your face sufficiently to wet and kill crawling cockroaches and ants and flying insects in all rooms, garages, and basements. Also spray thoroughly into insect hiding place surfaces, such as wall and floor cracks, moist areas, openings under and around sinks, pipes, and appliances, baseboards, cabinets, drawers, and closets. Spray on inside window glass and surfaces in other warm places indoors that attract and harbor flies.

OUTDOORS: Hold container upright 24 inches from surfaces, and spray away from your face sufficiently to wet and kill crawling ants, roaches, and flying insects. To break up ant trails on sidewalks, paths, and buildings, spray ants thoroughly along the entire path and all surfaces up to one foot either side of the trail. Repeat this treatment a second time if ants reappear on the same trail a few days later. Liberally spray and thoroughly wet manure heaps, compost piles, and insect-attracting garbage pails and dumpsters to kill flies, cockroaches, and ants and their eggs, larvae, and pupae on contact. Avoid spraying bees, ladybugs, butterflies, grasshoppers, and non-target insects.

BARBECUES & PICNICS: Enjoy an insect-free barbecue or picnic by first spraying the chosen patio, grass, or ground surface a few minutes or so before your party starts. Direct the spray away from your face 24 inches toward all surfaces you wish to keep free of crawling and flying insects.

Storage and Disposal:

Storage: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.
