On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Reg. No. 45987-4".
- b. As stated in our letter of August 16, 1994, the only label claims considered to be supported by the submitted efficacy data are claims for use as a housefly repellent when the product is hung or placed in areas where flies are attracted such as garbage cans provided the strip is replaced with a fresh one every three hours. Accordingly, the following claims are not appropriate use sites for a housefly repellent strip and must be deleted: "other enclosures"; and "auto, boat, golfcart, and other recreational vehicles."
- c. The claim that the product can be used "anywhere" is too broad and encompassing and must be deleted.

Accordingly, revise the statements, "Remove BUGCHASER REPELLENT STRIP from reusable barrier bag and place or hang anywhere houseflies can be a nuisance." and "The BUGCHASER REPELLENT STRIP can be hung or placed anywhere indoors or outdoors where houseflies are attracted and BUGCHASER protection is desired." to read as follows.

"Remove BUGCHASER BRAND REPELLENT STRIP from reusable barrier bag and place or hang where houseflies can be a nuisance."

"The BUGCHASER BRAND REPELLENT STRIP can be hung or placed indoors or outdoors on garbage cans and in homes where houseflies are attracted and housefly protection is desired."

d. As stated in item three of our August 16, 1994 letter, based on the available data, the proposed product name is considered to be misleading for the product and must be revised to reflect the supporting data. Accordingly, the designation "BRAND" must be added immediately after the word "BUGCHASER" and in the same type size and prominence. This revision is to be made in the product name and wherever the word "BUGCHASER" appears throughout the label.

e. Your expansion of the sites of use to include areas other than garbage cans necessitates the addition of the following statement pending finalization of your proposed food additive regulation.

"Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants, or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed."

3. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

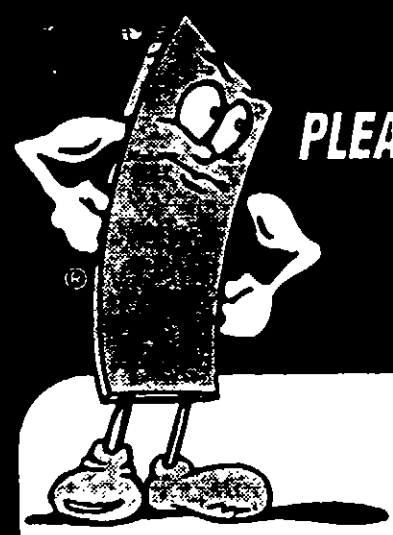

Use in locations such as garbage cans, other enclosures and in home, auto, boat, boat and other recreational vehicles. Replace with a fresh strip when the fragrance dissipates. Replacement with a fresh strip may be needed every 5 hours to maintain satisfactory repellency against houseflies.
