On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the following label changes before you release the product for shipment:

a. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 45987-5"

b. Add the following restrictions to the use directions: "This product is restricted to outdoor residential use only. Not for commercial use."

Consideration towards the removal of these restrictions will be made upon submittal of the appropriate proposed food additive regulations. They may be submitted as an amendment to your petition for the exemption of the requirement of a tolerance (3H5673) and should be worded as stated below.

"Sect. 185.XXX d-Limonene is exempt from the requirement of a food additive tolerance when used with dihydro-5-pentyl-2(3H)-furanone and dihydro-5-heptyl-2(3H)-furanone in tablecloths.

Sect. 185.XXX Dihydro-5-pentyl-2(3H)-furanone is exempt from the requirement of a food additive tolerance when used with d-limonene and dihydro-5-heptyl-2(3H)-furanone in tablecloths.

Sect. 185.XXX Dihydro-5-heptyl-2(3H)-furanone is exempt from the requirement of a food additive tolerance when used with d-limonene and dihydro-5-pentyl-2(3H)-furanone in tablecloths."

c. Revise the front panel statement, "Keep Out of Reach of Children" to read as follows: "Do not allow children to play with this tablecloth"

d. The claims, "100% DEET-free" and "sanitary" are considered implied safety claims and must be deleted from the label.

e. Delete the all-inclusive claims for use on "other pests" and "other pesky insects". If there are other pests for which your product is to be used, revise your label to identify such pests and submit it along with appropriate supporting data as an amendment for our evaluation.

f. The claim "bug-free" is too promising and must be deleted.

g. The proposed label claim for use on mosquitoes is not supported by the submitted efficacy data and must be deleted. Representative field studies are required to support the claim. It is suggested that the Product Performance Guidelines be consulted for details of the field testing requirement.

h. The terms "Inert Ingredients" and "Active Ingredients" must be of equal type size and prominence and be aligned to the same margin.

i Delete the claims for use on ants and "no-see-ums" since no data regarding the repellency of this product to these insects have been submitted.

J. Since the only insect claim supported by data is flies, the statement, "Repels flying & crawling insects" is inappropriate and must be deleted.

3. Submit the data listed below, conducted in accordance with the Pesticide Assessment Guideline referred to below, no later than 12 months from the date of this Registration Notice.

Guideline No. 82-3 90 day dermal

In place of the 90 day dermal toxicity studies on each technical grade of the active ingredient, this study is to be conducted on your pending product, "Stop Bugging Insect Repellent" (EPA File Symbol 45987-G). This study may then be used to satisfy the 90 day dermal toxicity data requirement for all four of your products (EPA File Symbols 45987-G, -U, -L and EPA Reg. No. 45987-1) since each contains the same percentage amounts of the three

active ingredients and since the dermal exposure will be much lower than the test product. All data generated and submitted must comply with the Good Laboratory Practice rule(40 CFR Part 160) and be in conformance with the requirements of PR Notice 86-5.

4. Submit the percentage of each component present in the inert ingredient substance listed on your Confidential Statement of Formula(CSF) and the trade name of the inert ingredient within 6 months of the date of this Registration Notice. The information recently received from your supplier did not include this information. Your supplier may contact us directly referencing your EPA Reg. No. in their response.

5. Submit your revised CSF showing the correct name and address for your supplier of the inert ingredient within 6 months from the date of this Registration Notice. In your phone conversation of October 5, 1993 with a member of my staff, you verified that the September 30, 1993 FAX from your supplier listing the components of the inert ingredient was for the subject product. The name and address of your supplier of the inert ingredient listed on your current CSF, however, is for a different firm.

6. Submit two copies of the revised final printed label for our files prior to releasing the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Storage: To maximize repellency life, store the tablecloth sealed in its package.
