Subject: Bugchaser Brand™ Insect Repellent Tablecloth

Your revised label dated July 26, 1995

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes.

1. According to 40 CFR 156.10(a)(5), your label may not contain any statement that directly or indirectly implies that the pesticide is recommended or endorsed by any agency of the Federal Government. In addition, your label may not contain claims as to the safety of the pesticide or its ingredients. Therefore, you must delete the sentence "Approved by Federal Law for Safe Use in Food-Handling Establishments." In addition, you must change the **Notice to Consumers** to read as follows: "All three active ingredients in BUGCHASER's insect repellent tablecloth are registered for use in food-handling establishments." Delete the sentence "No other manufacturer of insect repellents and tablecloths can make this claim." Delete the sentence "Authority: 21 U.S.C. 346a & 348, Secs. 185.1975, 185.1985, & 185.3775."

2. The heading "Precautionary Statement" at the bottom of page 2 of your label is incorrect. Please change this heading to read "Storage and Disposal."

3. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
