The labeling submitted in connection with reregistration under the FIFRA, as amended is acceptable subject tot eh following comments:

- 1. Replace the "INSECTISAFE™ BRAND" (front panel) with "BUGCHASER™" because use of the word "Insectisafe" is misleading (40 CFR § 156.10(a)(5)(ix).
- Delete "and more" from "Repels pesky houseflies and more" statement because you have acceptable efficacy only against houseflies.

- 3. Replace "Enjoy a bug-free or BBQ" with "Enjoy an outdoor picnic or BBQ."
- 4. Delete "Weeks of Welcomed Protection" (front panel) and Weeks of Protection" (rear panel), as these statements are exaggeration of efficacy, which is misleading.
- 5. Delete "..and a bug free meal" (second sentence in second paragraph) under DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records. Submit two (2) copies of the final printed label before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e).
