EPA Registration No. 45987-9 Submissions Dated: June 9, 2009

The labeling referred to above submitted in connection with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended is acceptable with the following comments:

- On page 1, both directly above the logo and above the "Directions for Use" section, delete **both** phrases that say: "Use Around Food, Children, Pets and Fish" as these statements are inappropriate on labels unless the product is registered for direct application to these sites.
- On page 2, delete the logo that reads: "EnviroMan For a Healthier Earth," as phrases and logos
  that imply improved health, safety, etc are considered false and misleading and are unacceptable
  on pesticide labels.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Restriction: Do not spray plants, animals or food.

Two-Way Spray: Press button very lightly to get a narrow stream for insects hiding in cracks and crevices. Press firmly for a fine mist to spray surfaces where the listed insect pests crawl. Pests must be directly sprayed in order to be killed.

#### Indoors

To Kill Listed Crawling Pests: In a well-ventilated room, with nozzle pointing away from your face, directly spray pests that you see. May be used in structures such as homes, restaurants, hospitals, schools and food processing establishments. Specific sites where these pests may be found include kitchen cabinets, drawers and closets, under sinks and in wall and floor cracks and crevices. May be used in both edible and non-edible product areas of Federally-approved meat, poultry and egg producing establishments.

To Kill Fleas: Before spraying, test a corner of fabric for compatibility. Hold container tilted down away from your face and with a sweeping side-to-side motion spray carpets, rugs, dog and cat bedding and under furniture. Fleas contacted with the spray will be killed. One 15 oz. container treats 200 sq. ft. [One 12 oz. container treats 160 sq.ft. {or other appropriate conversion based on container size} Outdoors

To Kill Listed Crawling Pests Outdoors, Including Barbeque and Picnic Areas: Hold container upright: Spray away from your face sufficiently to wet ants and spiders\* that you see. Specific areas where you see these pests include outside buildings, windows, doors and sidewalks.

#### Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store container in a cool, dry place. Disposal: Do not puncture or incinerate! If empty: Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.

\*Except in California

#### First Aid

If Swallowed: Immediately call a poison control center or doctor. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

Note to Physician: Contains petroleum distillate. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
