2. Add to the water by a feeder device or by hand. If added by hand, add to a bucket of water and then pour into the pool.

**DIRECTIONS FOR DISINFECTION OF POTABLE WATER
FOR HOME WELL WATER SYSTEMS**

1. Add this product to the water in the ratio of 1/2 ounce per 10 gallons of water.

2. Let the water stand for 30 minutes before drinking or using for other purposes.

DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING FOOD PROCESSING OR DAIRY EQUIPMENT

1. Use this product to sanitize food processing or dairy equipment.
