1. Bring chlorine level to 1-1.5 ppm. Follow instructions below for your feeding device.
2. The day after your chlorine residual reached 1-1.5 ppm add stabilizer & conditioner to stabilize your pool. Follow label directions.
3. Adjust pH to ideal range of 7.2-7.6.

FOR USE IN FLOATER

1. Cut off the air vent that sticks out at top of cartridge.
2. Punch a hole through the lowest indentation on each side of the cartridge and insert into the floater. Do not punch holes in bottom. If more chlorination is needed punch as many holes as needed on each side starting at the lowest indentation and working up until the pool's free chlorine residual reaches 1.0 to 1.5 ppm.

FOR USE IN E-Z CHLOR FEEDER.

1. Punch all indentations on the bottom of the cartridge (or cut-off the three water vent areas that stick out on the sides near the bottom of the cartridge). Two cartridges may be needed in a pool 30,000 gallons or larger.
2. Do not cut off the air vent at the top of the cartridge.
3. Make sure that the screw lid is on tight.
4. Punch a hole through the lowest indentation on each side of the cartridge.
5. Insert cartridge into feeder. If more chlorination is needed, punch more holes on each side of the cartridge starting at the lowest indentation and working up until the free available chlorine residual remains within the range of 1 to 1.5 ppm.

FOR USE IN GUARDEX FEEDER 1: Cut off the air vent that sticks out near the top of the cartridge.

2. Cut off the three water vent areas that stick out on the sides near the bottom of the cartridge. Two cartridges may be needed in a pool 30,000 gallons or larger.
3. Insert the cartridge in the feeder adjusting the cartridge height until the free available chlorine level in the pool remains within the range of 1-1.5 ppm.
