#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

Severe algae growth such as black algae is resistant to normal chlorine levels and most liquid algaecides. This product is an extremely powerful algaecide and bactericide formulated specifically to kill problem algal growth.

- 1) For best results, adjust the pH level of the water to 7.2-7.6.
- 2) Before using this product, turn off your pool pump and remove any automatic pool cleaner.
- 3) Brush algae growth with a pool brush specifically designed for this purpose. Carefully sprinkle SPOT OUT directly over the algae growth (see chart below). Use care to prevent skin contact. The slow dissolving characteristic of this product allows concentrated chlorine to attack the growth and destroy it. During treatment process, the water should remain undisturbed for several hours before turning on pool pump.  
**DO NOT USE THE POOL FOR AT LEAST 24 HOURS OR UNTIL THE CHLORINE RESIDUAL HAS DROPPED TO 3 ppm OR LESS.**
- 4) Brush algae spots daily. A second application may be required.

FREQUENT USE OF THIS PRODUCT MAY DAMAGE POOL FINISH; CONSULT YOUR PROFESSIONAL POOL DEALER. DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT IN VINYL OR PAINTED POOLS AS DISCOLORATION OF THE FINISH MAY OCCUR.

**DANGER:** Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Do not handle with bare hands. **PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS:** Strong oxidizing agent. Mix only into water. Use clean dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Avoid contact with open flame or burning material such as lighted cigarette. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction, with generation of heat, liberation of hazardous gases, and possible generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water if necessary.

**PRACTICAL TREATMENT: (First Aid) IF SWALLOWED:** Drink large quantities of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Contact a physician immediately. **IF ON SKIN:** Brush off excess chemical and flush skin with cold water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, get medical attention. **IF IN EYES:** Flush with cold water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention. **IF INHALED:** Remove person to fresh air. Call a physician immediately.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. In case of decomposition, isolate container if possible and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instruction, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
