The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the **Busan 77 RED**, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable. The label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is <u>not</u> yet being reregistered under section 4(g) of FIFRA.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Algaecide 30 is used to control the growth of algae in swimming pools, exterior spas, whirlpools, hot tubs, [decorative fountains and ponds that do not contain fish]. For maximum effectiveness pools, spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs, [decorative fountains and ponds] containing heavy growth of algae should be cleaned prior to using **Algaecide 30**. For pools having just visible algae growth add an initial dose of 24 to 32 fluid ounces of **Algaecide 30** per 10,000 gallons of water and remove settled algae debris by cleaning. For treatment of a freshly cleaned and filled pool add initially 13 to 24 ounces of **Algaecide 30** per 10,000 gallons of 4 to 9 fluid ounces of **Algaecide 30** should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Spas, whirlpools, and hot tubs, [decorative fountains and ponds] having just visible algae growth require an initial dose of 2 to 4 ounces of **Algaecide 30** per 1,000 gallons of water. Subsequent additions of 0.5 to 0.8 fluid ounces of **Algaecide 30** should be made every 5 to 7 days after initial treatment for maintenance.

Algaecide 30 will prevent growth of most algae during the off-season winter months when pools are not in use. For pools, which have been properly treated during the swimming season and are free of visible algae, add 13 to 21 fluid ounces of **Algaecide 30** per 10,000 gallons of water. If at the end of swimming season pools have some visible algae growth, add 25 to 32 fluid ounces per 10,000 gallons. It is necessary that a uniform distribution of algaecide, throughout the water and the pool be made for maximum effectiveness. If pool is not covered, it may be necessary to repeat the treatment one or more times during the season.

Algaecide 30 is compatible with those chemicals normally used to treat pools and spas and is effective at both acid and alkaline pH. Algaecide 30 can be used in pools and spas treated with chlorine chemicals and may reduce the amount of those chemicals normally required. However, do not mix Algaecide 30 with concentrated dry or liquid chlorine products.
