
Dear Ms. Kollen:

The Agency has completed it its review of the 8 month response to the Copper Compounds II RED Product-Specific data (toxicity and product chemistry) and concludes that all of the data is acceptable.

Upon revision of the label as indicated below, the requirements per the Copper Compounds II RED will have been satisfied. However since this product has two active ingredients, it is not eligible for reregistration at this time. The product may be reregistered after the Product-specific data requirements of the Alkyl Dimethyl Benzyl Ammonium Chloride (ADBAC) RED have also been satisfied.

The following label revisions must be made:

- 1. Revise the last statement in the first paragraph under the "Directions for Use" by increasing the reentry interval time from 10 minutes to "15 minutes."
- 2. Revise the "Precautionary Statements" to read "Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if absorbed through skin. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Avoid breathing vapor. Wear goggles or face-shield, protective clothing, and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.
- 3. Revise the "Storage and Disposal" instructions for household/residential use containers by adding the following storage statement, "Store in a locked storage area inaccessible to children and persons unfamiliar with its use."

Do not mix this algaecide with soap or other cleaners. Do not premix with other water treating chemicals. These chemicals must be handled separately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product controls the growth of problem algae in swimming pools. Brush algae spots prior to application. If necessary brush once after each day for two days following application. This product comes concentrated; therefore, dilute the proper dosage of the concentrate with at least nine parts of water. The appropriate amount of product must be added by pouring directly into the pool along the edges while the filter and pump are in operation. To allow time for even distribution on pool water, bathers must allow 10 minutes after treatment before entering pool.

INITIAL APPLICATION: (Free of Visible Algae/Start of Season): Apply 12 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

If Algae Growth is Visible: Apply initial dose, then vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If pool is heavy with algae growth, first brush algae spots, vacuum, clean and scrub the pool walls. Apply initial dose, then vacuum remaining algae debris.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Apply 6 oz of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water every 5 to 7 days. NOTE: After heavy or prolonged rainfall, high prevailing temperatures, or heavy swimming use, add the maintenance dose more frequently.

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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
