On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act. Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or recommendation of this product by the Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, on his motion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or to its use if it has been covered by others.

Based on your response to the Copper Compounds II RED, the EPA has reregistered this product subject to the comments recorded in the succeeding paragraph. This action is taken under the authority of section 4(g) (2) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Acts, as amended. Registration under this section does not eliminate the need for continual reassessment of pesticides. The EPA may require submission of data at any time to maintain the registration of the subject product.

The following label revisions must be made:

- 1. Per the acute toxicity review, the signal word "CAUTION" must be revised to read "DANGER."

2. Per the product chemistry review, revisions are needed to the ingredient statement.

- The active ingredient name "Copper" must be changed to Copper Ethanolamine Complex.
- Per the RED, the CAS number for Copper Ethanolamine Complex must be added under the Ingredients statements.
- The statement "(from Copper Ethanolamine Complex)" must be replaced with "Metallic Copper Equivalent – 7.41%."

3. Per the acute toxicity review, the revisions noted in **bold type** below must be made to the first aid statements and based on toxicity ranking the statements should be placed on the label in the following order:

IF IN EYES:

Hold **eye** open and rinse slowly **and gently** with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:

Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF SWALLOWED:

Call a poison control center **or doctor immediately** for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF INHALED:

Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferable mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice."

4. A Note to Physician must be added to the label and must read:

"Note to Physician
Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage."

The Agency recommends that additional text be added to the Note to Physician that addresses eye and skin irritation concerns.

- 5. Per the acute toxicity review, the Precautionary Statement Section must be revised to read:


"DANGER

Corrosive. Causes irreversible eye damage. Causes skin burns. Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear coveralls over long-sleeved shirt, long pants, chemical-resistant footwear, goggles or face shield, socks, chemical-resistant gloves and an apron when mixing, loading or cleaning equipment."

- 6. Per the RED, the text "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets either directly or through drift" must be added to the label.

The Agency anticipates an amended Copper Compounds II RED will be finalized by the end of FY 2010. Additional labeling language may be required at that time. For additional information, please refer to the enclosed EPA reviews. Submit three (3) copies of the revised labeling bearing the labeling revisions listed above. CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not mix this algaecide with soap or other cleaners. Do not pre-mix with other water treating chemicals. These chemicals must be handled separately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Dilute the appropriate amount of product with at least nine parts water and pour directly into pool along the edges while the filter and pump are in operation. To allow time for even distribution in pool water, bathers must allow 10 minutes after treatment before entering pool.

INITIAL APPLICATION: Free of Visible Algae/Start of Season: Apply 2 oz of this product per 5000 gallons of pool water (or equivalent) under sunny conditions for most effective results.

Algae Growth is Visible: Apply initial dose, then vacuum pool after 24 hours to remove dead algae. If pool is heavy with algae growth, first brush algae spots, vacuum, clean and scrub the pool walls. Apply initial dose, then vacuum remaining algae debris.

MAINTENANCE DOSE: Apply 1 oz of product per 5000 gallons of pool water (or equivalent) every 5 to 7 days. Note: After heavy or prolonged rainfall, high prevailing temperatures, or heavy swimming use, add the maintenance dose more frequently.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reaction in some individuals. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, or using tobacco.

FIRST AID:

IF SWALLOWED: Call a poison control center immediately for treatment advice. Have the person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or a doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and rinse slowly with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses if present after 5 minutes then continue rinsing eye. Call poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

IF INHALED: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

This pesticide is toxic to fish.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Store in original container in cool, dry place. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.
