

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

**Application and Dosage Rate:**

VISIBLE ALGAE GROWTH: 48 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

INITIAL CLEAN WATER TREATMENT: 27 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water.

MAINTENANCE: 12 oz. of this product per 10,000 gallons of pool water weekly.

Pools containing heavy algae growth must be cleaned prior to using this product. 24 hours after treating visible algae growth, algae debris must be removed by standard cleaning procedures. Dilute Pool Algaecide 20] {enter brand name} with at least three parts water before applying. Pour the required amount of this product into plastic watering can and fill with water. Maintaining constant pool circulation, sprinkle solution around the edge of the pool.

**Winterizing Treatment:** [Pool Algaecide 20] {enter brand name} will control the growth of most algae in pools during the winter months. If there is no visible algae growth in the pool at the end of the swimming season, add 26 oz. of [Pool Algaecide 20] {enter brand name} per 10,000 gallons of water. For pools that have visible algae growth, add 48 oz. of [Pool Algaecide 20] {enter brand name} per 10,000 gallons of water. Dilute the dosage with at least three parts water and apply uniformly. If there is no pool cover, repeat this process one or two more times during the winter season.
