Insert automatic dishwasher sanitizer container for automatic dispensing. One (0.5 flu. oz.) (1 TBSP) of "LEW" per 4 gallons will provide 50 PPM available chlorine.

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use kit and increase dosage as necessary to maintain required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, clean area with large quantities of water. Rinse thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or discard by placing in trash collection or approved landfill.  rinse, and shall be serviced by the authorized Low Energy
 Warewashing serviceman.

Insert automatic dishwasher sanitizer supply tube in
 container for automatic dispensing. One half fluid ounce,
 (0.5 flu. oz.) (1 TBSP) of "LEW" per 4 gallons of rinse water
 will provide 50 PPM available chlorine.

NOTE: This product degrades with age. Use a chlorine test
 kit and increase dosage as necessary, to obtain the
 required level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in a cool,
 dry area away from direct sunlight. In case of spill, flood
 area with large quantities of water. Rinse empty container
 thoroughly with water and either return to manufacturer or
 discard by placing in trash collection or burying in an
 approved landfill. Product or rinsate that cannot be used,
 should be diluted with water and disposed of in a sanitary
 sewer. Do not contaminate food, or feed by storage,
 disposal or cleaning of equipment.
