The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, to add a 5-step sanitation procedure to your label is acceptable provide that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling.

1. Revise the EPA Registration Number to read, "EPA Reg. No. 46183-6.  
  
This is an amendment to the primary registration for this product and not just the distributor product.
2. On front panel, under the "Active Ingredients" remove the "Available Chlorine 12 1/2%" statement and place it outside the "Ingredients Statement".
3. Place the signal word "DANGER" immediately below "Keep Out of Reach of Children".
4. Under the "Environmental Hazards" statement revise the first sentence to read: "This pesticide is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms".
5. In the "Statement of Practical Treatment" revise:
  - "Skin" to read: "If on Skin".
  - "Eyes" to read: "If in Eyes".

"Ingestion" to read: "If Swallowed"

6. On the second page, delete "Danger", "Keep Out of Reach of Children" and "Harmful If Swallowed".

The name of records for this product is Bioway TCL Chlorinating Sanitizer. Please refer to this name for registration issues, unless you choose to **officially change** the name.

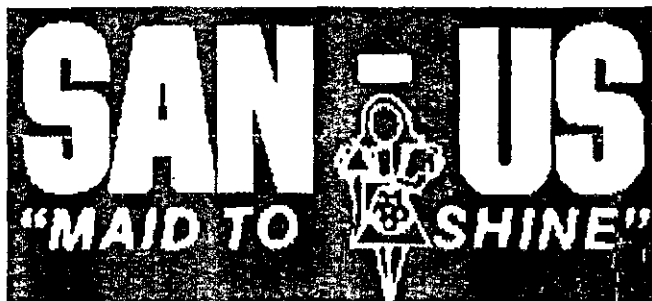

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SAN-US P-D-C is a stable, soluble chlorinating sanitizer for dairies, dairy processing plants, and other related areas. The sanitizing solution may be applied by spraying, soaking or recirculation.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### GLASSES AND DISHES 5 STEP SANITIZING PROCEDURE

- 1) Pre-flush or pre-scrape equipment and utensils. If needed pre-soak to remove gross food particles and soil.
- 2) Wash equipment and utensils in lukewarm water that contains an adequate amount of detergent or cleaner. Keep this water clean by changing frequently.
- 3) Rinse equipment and utensils free of wash water prior to sanitizing.
- 4) Sanitize equipment and utensils by immersing them in a solution of 1 oz. (2 tablespoonfuls) P-D-C dissolved in 10 gallons of water (provides 100 ppm available chlorine) or 1 tablespoonful in 5 gallons water. Allow sanitizing solution to remain in contact with surfaces for 2 minutes. Follow the recommendations of your local Health Department.
- 5) After sanitizing for 2 minutes or more allow equipment and utensils to air dry. Do not rinse.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Keep product dry in tightly closed container when not in use. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container if possible and flood with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding. Place in trash collection or dispose in approved landfill area.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENT HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS DANGER

Highly corrosive. Causes skin and eye damage. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Irritating to nose and throat. Avoid breathing dust. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. #### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact the regional office of the EPA.

#### PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

**Strong Oxidizing Agent:** Mix only with water. Use clean dry utensils. Do not add this product to any dispensing device containing remnants of any other product. Such use may cause a violent reaction leading to fire or explosion. Contamination with moisture, organic matter, or other chemicals may start a chemical reaction, with generation of fire and explosion. In case of contamination or decomposition, do not reseal container. If possible isolate container in open air or well ventilated area. Flood with large volumes of water if necessary.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**SKIN:** Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.  
**EYES:** Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady, gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.  
**INGESTION:** Get medical attention. Promptly drink a large quantity of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol.  
**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
