APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

WHERE TO USE

For use only on interior, hard, non-porous interior ceilings, walls, doors, and trim in commercial and institutional buildings.

Drying time and Recoating interval **

Drying time 1 Hr Recoating interval 4 Hr

Drying and recoat times are dependent on temperature, humidity and film thickness

Coverage and thickness

Apply 2 coats with brush or roller

Coverage: 250 to 273 sq. ft/gal at 50 to 60 microns DFT. This equates to application rates ranging from a minimum of 6.12 ounces permethrin/1000ft² to a maximum of 7.87 ounces permethrin/1000ft².

Surface Preparation and Priming

^{**}Drying time and recoating interval for 77°F/50 R.H.

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All Surfaces: Properly prepare and clean all surfaces. Remove loose paint, wash off dirt and grease with detergent, rinse and allow to dry. Remove mildew stains with mildew stain remover. Scuff glossy surface and repair imperfections. Remove all dust with a damp cloth, allow to dry. Allow new stucco plaster and masonry to cure at least for 30 days before painting. Use a premium wall/wood primer for an undercoat to seal pores or repair interior surfaces including wood that contains tanning (two primer coats required for redwood and cedar).

Application – Apply when air and surface temperature are between 50 to 89°F. Stir paint occasionally. Use a high quality 3/8 - 1/2 inch nap roller cover, nylon/polyester brush. Darker colors may require an additional coat.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: Store away from food and pet food. **Open dumping is prohibited.** Keep container closed when not in use. Do not transfer contents to other containers. Store in a cool, dry place away from heat. To prevent from freezing, store the paint above 41°F.
