**DIRECTIONS FOR USE
GENERAL CLASSIFICATION**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

CWT-255 is used to control mold and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial air conditioning systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove skin, scale, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 120 fluid ounces of CWT-255 to 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 48 to 120 parts per million of CWT-255, based on the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dosage of 1.53 to 1.53 CWT-255 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of air-washing systems that maintain effective mist eliminators. To its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 24.7 to 41.2 CWT-255 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each 1 to 2 weeks. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in collection trays of the airwash system.
