The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes indicated below prior to release for shipment of product bearing the amended labeling.

1. Change the Note To Physician to read as follows:

Note to Physician: Disulfoton is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

2. Update the Environmental Hazards by changing "by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes" to "when disposing of equipment wash waters."

3. Make the following changes on the labels ingredients statements:

a. The word "Disulfoton" should precede the chemical name.

b) Delete "(By Weight)"

c) Change "Active Ingredients" to the singular.

d) The word "Total" should precede "100%."

The following comments deal with the chemistry of the products.

1. Provide the upper and lower certified limits based on the pure active ingredient rather than the technical or concentrate. Note that the lower limit of the active must not fall below the label claim.

2. The upper and lower certified limits are listed in the wrong columns.

3. Re-calculate the percent by weight values. There are several errors based on the amounts of each component divided by the total batch weight.

Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.
