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GENERAL INFORMATION:

Jobe's Spikes with Di-Syston Insecticide are an effective way to control pests on nursery, greenhouse and landscape plants while providing continuous feeding of secondary and minor nutrients. Jobe's unique patented slow-release formulation provides systemic pest control and nutrition for up to sixty days. Soil moisture gradually dissolves the spike, releasing a systemic insecticide as well as a special blend of secondary and minor nutrients. The insecticide and nutrients enter the plant through the roots and are translocated to all parts of the plant to feed and protect against chewing and sucking insects.

Protects against stem and foliar damage caused by:

Aphids, Birch Leaf Miner, Camellia Scale, Elm Leaf Beetle, European Elm Scale, Holly Leaf Miner, Lace Bug, Leafhoppers, Mimosa Webworm, Mites, Pine Tip Moth, Soft Scale (*Coccus hesperidum*), Tea Scale, Thrips and Whiteflies.

For use on most Ornamentals, Flowers, Shrubs, Trees (including non-bearing Fruit and Nut Trees) and Forest Planting.

FOR BEST RESULTS, INSERT SPIKES EVERY SIX TO EIGHT WEEKS depending on irrigation schedule. Wear protective gloves when handling this product. Irrigate immediately after application.

For Field-Grown and Landscape Plants: Make a hole and insert the spike 1-1/2 inches under the soil on opposite sides of the plant 10 to 12 inches from the stem. Use one spike per foot of shrub foliage diameter.

For Containerized Nursery, Greenhouse and Landscape Plants: Make a hole and insert the spike 1-1/2 inches under the soil on opposite sides of the plant close to the edge of the container.
