6	1	Use 2 spikes per square foot of plant bed or 1 spike per plant, applied no closer than 3 inches from the stem. Push spikes completely under the soil and water immediately.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store only in original container in a cool, dry, place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap and discard in trash.

CAUTION

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting.

IF ON SKIN: Wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Disulfoton is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.
