ALGAE-OUT 10 is used to control algae and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove algae, slime, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of ALGAE-OUT 10 fluid ounces of ALGAE-OUT 10 per 1000 gallons of water to provide a concentration of 48 to ALGAE-OUT 10, based on the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dosage

Subsequent slug additions of 1.53 to ALGAE-OUT 10 per 1000 gallons of ALGAE-OUT 10 employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump or

ALGAE-OUT 10 is used to clean air-washing systems that maintain effective mist level to its use, systems should be cleaned to remove deposits. An initial slug dose of 24.7 to ALGAE-OUT 10 per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each time. Frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made in collection trays of the airwash system.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not stack more than four drums high. Leaking or damaged drums for disposal. Spills should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and container closed when not in use.
