WARNING: Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this pesticide inconsistent with its labeling.

AB CONTROL is

in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems must be cleaned to remove algal and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 6 AB CONTROL per

gallon is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is achieved.

Subsequent slug additions of 2.3 AB CONTROL per 1000 gallons

every 1 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of additions should be made in the sump of water

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. **STORAGE:** Do not expose to extreme temperatures. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not store in five drums high. Drums should be opened in a well-ventilated area. Damaged drums should be placed in overpack and should be absorbed in sawdust or sand and disposed of in a container closed when not in use.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Do not reuse excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate in a manner that causes contamination. Pesticide cannot be disposed of by use according to local, State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency regulations.
