HOW TO USE:
Ready to Use Systemic Weed & Grass Killer is a non selective herbicide that kills undesirable vegetation on contact with the convenient trigger sprayer, spray unwanted weeds and grasses until plant surfaces are wet. Spray just enough to wet plant. Do not saturate. One application should kill most weeds listed. Hard to control, perennial weeds such as Canada thistle, Bermudagrass or Field bindweed may require more than one application if not completely killed within 4 weeks. Do not cut treated vegetation for at least 7 days after treatment.

READ ATTACHED PAMPHLET FOR COMPLETE DIRECTIONS FOR USE.

ATTENTION: Ready to Use Systemic Weed & Grass Killer is a non selective post-emergent herbicide that kills on contact. The spray mist is absorbed and translocated throughout the treated plant, moving from the foliage down into the stem and roots, to kill the whole plant and prevent regrowth from underground plant parts. Be careful when applying so that desirable plants are not sprayed as they will be killed also. Apply when air is calm to avoid spray contact with desirable plants. Do not apply if rain is expected within 24 hours of application as effectiveness will be reduced. If desirable foliage is sprayed, immediately wash off with water.

WHEN USING SPRAYER FOR THE FIRST TIME, TILT UPWARD SO THAT TRAPPED AIR CAN ESCAPE FROM SYSTEM.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL
Protect from freezing. When empty container is discarded wrap container and put in trash collection.

Kills tough weeds and grasses, in walks, driveways, gravel or bark ground mulch, flower beds, lawns, or around trees and shrubs.

Ready to Use Systemic Weed & Grass Killer is easy to use for spot treatment to single weeds or application to specific areas. The formulation moves systemically through all parts of the

plant killing leaves to stems down to the roots. Usually within one week browning will occur on most weeds, with complete kill developing in 2 to 4 weeks.

HOW TO USE:

Ready to Use Weed & Grass Killer is non-selective and can kill all vegetation contacted. Use hand trigger applicator so that the spray covers the area occupied by the unwanted weeds or grasses. Stand 1 to 2 feet away from plant to be treated. Sprayer nozzle should be aimed at weed and away from face. Nozzle should allow a coarse spray to be emitted on the center of undesired plant. Spray enough to wet plant, do not saturate. One application should kill most weeds listed. Hard to control perennial weeds such as Canada thistle, Bermudagrass, or field bindweed may require more than one application if not completely controlled within 4 weeks. Treated areas in lawns can be reseeded 7 days after application.

ATTENTION: Ready to Use Systemic Weed & Grass Killer is a contact herbicide that can completely kill all green foliage tissue. When spraying, be careful not to accidentally spray desirable plants as they can also be killed. Apply only when air is calm to avoid spray hitting desirable plants. Do not use when rain is predicted within 24 hours as effectiveness will be reduced. If desirable foliage is sprayed immediately wash off with water.

DIRECTIONS FOR PREPARING REFILL

Use empty container to mix the new solution. Add 1 part Systemic Weed & Grass Killer to 9 parts clean tap water to make the .5% solution. For example Add 18 oz. of water to 2 oz. of the product. Follow directions for use above and on label.
