



SHOOT-OUT™ kills weeds & grasses systemically. The spray mist is absorbed by the leaves and moves throughout the stems and roots to kill the entire plant. Regrowth from the roots is prevented.

This product is a non-selective, post-emergent herbicide that kills undesirable vegetation including: Bahagrass, Bewickgrass, Bindweed (Wild Morning-glory), Bluegrass, Canada Thistle, Clover, Crabgrass, Galleggass, Goosefoot, Goosefoot, Fescue, Johnsongrass, Knotgrass, Lamb's quarters, Ragweed, Orchardgrass, and others.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE. It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO USE. To apply with aluminum, stainless steel or plastic tank sprayers, add one cup (8 oz.) of SHOOT-OUT™ Concentrate (5%) to one gallon of clean water to cover 250 sq. ft. or add this pint (16 oz.) to 2 gallons of clean water to cover 500 sq. ft.

NOTE. Using galvanized or unlined steel tank sprayers is not recommended. However, if a galvanized or unlined steel tank is used, the solution must be used immediately. **DO NOT STORE UNUSED SPRAY.** Always rinse sprayer after use.

HOSE-END SPRAYERS. The Super K-Gro Adjustable Lawn & Garden Sprayer is recommended for treating large areas. (NOTE: Tank type sprayer, SHOOT-OUT™ aerosol or trigger sprayer (24 oz.) is recommended for making treatments around trees and shrubs or spot treatments in lawns.) Pour the desired amount of the concentrate into the sprayer jar. Do not add water to the sprayer jar. Turn the outside selector knob to the 4 gallon setting. Place front nozzle in the down spray position. Attach to a garden hose and spray. Use 8 oz. of the concentrate to cover 250 sq. ft. or this pint (16 oz.) to cover 500 sq. ft.

IMPORTANT: AVOID SPRAY CONTACT OF DESIRABLE PLANTS AS THEY WILL ALSO BE KILLED. If contact does occur, wash off spray immediately with water. For best results, use on a warm, sunny day when rain is not expected within 24 hours. Avoid cutting treated plants for 7 days.

HARD TO KILL WEEDS. For some hard to control vines and weeds, a second application may be required if not completely killed in 4 weeks.

DIRECTIONS FOR REFILLING THE SHOOT-OUT™ READY-TO-USE TRIGGER SPRAYER. The Ready to Use solution can be mixed in the empty 24 oz. trigger sprayer bottle. Add 9 tablespoons (4 1/2 oz.) of this concentrate to the container and flush filling bottle with clean water (16 oz.) (2 tablespoons = 1 fl. oz.)
