Repeat weekly or throughout the growing season when insects are present. Reapply after rain. For best results, spray early in the morning when air is still and temperatures are cool. Regular light sprayings at 2-3 day intervals are generally more effective than single heavy treatments.
PLANTS: Tomatoes, Beans, Peppers, Lettuce, Asparagus, Broccoli, Cauliflower, Cabbage, Brussels Sprouts, Celery, Cranberries, Eggplants, Mustard Greens, Kale, Collards, Turnips, Potatoes, Radishes, Spinach and Corn.
KILLS: Aphids, Leafhoppers, Japanese Beetles, White Flies, Mexican Bean Beetles, Cucumber Beetles, Imported Cabbageworms, Harlequin Bugs, Cabbageworms, Tomato Fruitworms, Stink Bugs, Diamondback Moth Larvae, Flea Beetles, Webworms, Potato Beetles, Colorado Potato Beetles, Wireworms, Cabbage Looper and Corn Earworms.
NOTE: For Corn Earworms, set nozzle to stream and spray into corn silk. Make 3 to 4 applications at 2-3 day intervals.
