The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

The Precautionary Statements must be amended to read as follows:

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

The "If Swallowed" part of the Statement of Practical Treatment must be amended as follows:

If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

The container disposal statement must be modified as follows:

Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Delete the label the reference to making this product for Kmart Corp. This language is associated with supplemental distribution. If you wish to obtain a supplemental distributor

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **FOR USE AROUND THE HOME ONLY.**

HOW TO USE: Shake well before using. [Adjust nozzle to a fine spray.] Hold sprayer 12-15 inches from plant and spray, thoroughly covering both upper and lower leaf surfaces. Use caution on new growth and tender foliage. Repeat as needed [throughout the growing season] when insects are present. [Reapply after rain. For best results, spray early in the morning when air is still and temperatures are cool.] Regular light sprayings at 2-3 day intervals are generally more effective than single heavy treatments. [Do not use on succulents such as Jade or cactus.]

USE ON THE FOLLOWING VEGETABLES: Asparagus, Beans, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Celery, Collards, Corn, Cranberries, Eggplant, Kale, Lettuce, Mustard Greens, Peppers, Potatoes, Radishes, Spinach, Tomatoes and Turnips. May be applied up to the day of harvest.

KILLS THE FOLLOWING INSECTS ON VEGETABLES: Aphids, Cabbage Looper, Cabbageworms, Caterpillars, Colorado Potato Beetles, Corn Earworms, Cucumber Beetles, Diamond Moth Larvae, Flea Beetles, Harlequin Bugs, Imported Cabbageworms, Japanese Beetles, Leafhoppers, Mexican Bean Beetles, Potato Beetles, Tomato Fruitworms, Tomato Hornworms, Stink Bugs, Webworms, Whiteflies and Wireworms. **NOTE:** For Corn Earworms, set nozzle to stream and spray into corn silk.
