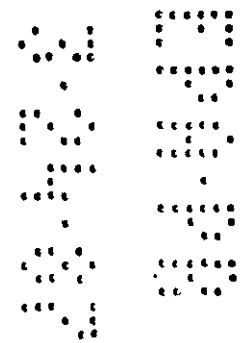

**HOW TO USE:** Shake well before using. Mixes readily with water and may be used in most types of sprayers. To use with Super K-Gro<sup>R</sup> hose-end sprayer, carefully read the complete directions that are on the hose-end sprayer jar. Add the amount of concentrate specified for each gallon of diluted spray required. Next, fill the hose-end sprayer jar with water to the appropriate level as marked on the side of the hose-end sprayer jar. Apply during cool, calm and dry periods of the day, when trees and plants are not under hot, direct rays of the sun, and rain is not expected within 24 hours. Use 2 tsp. (1/3 fl. oz.) per gal. of water. Begin spraying after blooming or when pests first appear and repeat at 7-10 day intervals, as necessary. Spray plant thoroughly, especially upper and lower leaf surfaces. Do not treat food crops grown in the greenhouse. Do not feed treated vines to livestock. For Codling Moths on Apple Trees, 4-6 sprays are required. Light russeting may occur on some varieties of Apples, such as Golden Delicious.

**Note:** Numbers in ( ) indicate days required between last application and harvest. Wash fruits and vegetables thoroughly before using.

**FRUITS & NUTS -** For use on; Strawberries(5), Figs(5), Blueberries(7), Canberries(7), Apricots(10), Cherries(10), Grapes(10), Nectarines(10), Plums(10), Prunes(10), Apples(14), Pears(14), Grapefruit(21), Lemons(21), Oranges(21), Peaches(21). For Almonds, Filberts, Walnuts, and Pecans, do not apply after husks crack or open. To control; Aphids, Apple Maggots, Blueberry Maggots, Cherry Fruit Flies, Cherry Fruitworms (Maggots), Citrus Thrips, Codling Moths, Cranberry Fruitworm, Dried Fruit Beetles, Fruit Tree Leaf Rollers, Casebearers, Pear Psylla, Raspberry Sawflies, Raspberry Fruitworms, Scale Crawlers, Strawberry Leafroller, Tentiform Leafminers, Thrips, Vinegar Flies, Walnut Caterpillars.

**VEGETABLES -** For use on; Tomatoes(1), Peas(1), Sweet Corn(1), Cantaloupes(3), Muskmelons(3), Watermelons(3), Winter Squash(3), Broccoli(5), Peppers(5), Cauliflower(5), Beans(7), Cabbage(7), Cucumber(7), Summer Squash(7), Carrots(10), Celery(10), Lettuce(10), Spinach(10), Onions(10), Radishes(10), Turnips(10), Potatoes(35). To control; Aphids, Armyworms, Colorado Potato Beetles, Cucumber Beetles, Diamond Back Moths (larvae), Dipterous Leafminers, Flea Beetles, Grasshoppers, Mexican Bean Beetles, Mites, Onion Thrips, Thrips, Vinegar Flies and Whiteflies.
