1. Make the correction as requested in item -d- of our letter of January 18, 1991 by deleting the commodity "lettuce" from the crop listing.

2. The name change from "K-Gro All Purpose Garden Spray" to "Super-K-Gro[®] All Purpose Garden Spray" is acceptable.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO USE: Shake well before using. Adjust nozzle to a fine spray. Hold sprayer 12-15 inches from plant and spray thoroughly covering both upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat weekly or throughout the growing season when insects are present up to days of harvest given for each crop. Reapply after rain. For best results, spray early in the morning when air is still and temperatures are cool.

FOR USE ON THE FOLLOWING GARDEN VEGETABLES: Artichoke (7), Broccoli (3), Cabbage (3), Carrots (7), Cauliflower (3), Collards (7), Cucumber (3), Eggplant (7), Green Peas (3), Lettuce (7), Melons (3), Peppers (7), Potatoes (7), Pumpkins (3), Radishes (7), Snap Beans (3), Squash (3), Sweet Corn (1), and Tomatoes (1).

NOTE: Numbers in () indicate days required between last application and harvest.

CONTROLS: Alfalfa Caterpillar, Alfalfa Looper, Aphid, Armyworm, Artichoke Plume Moth, Beet Armyworm, Buckthorn Aphid, Cabbage Looper, Carrot Weevil, Celery Looper, Chinch Bug, Colorado Potato Beetle, Corn Earworm, Corn Rootworm (adults), Cowpea Curculio, Cucumber Beetle (adults) - spotted and striped, Cutworm, Diamondback Moth, European Corn Borer, Flea Beetle, Grasshopper, Green Cloverworm, Imported Cabbageworm, Leafhopper, Looper, Lygus Bug, Mexican Bean Beetle, Painted Lady Caterpillar, Pea Aphid, Pea Weevil, Pepper Weevil, Pickleworm, Potato Leafhopper, Potato Psyllid, Potato Tuberworm, Rindworm, Saltmarsh Caterpillar, Sap Beetle, Southwestern Corn Borer, Squash Bug, Squash Vine Borer, Stalk Borer, Stink Bug, Tarnished Plant Bug, Tobacco Hornworm, Tomato Fruitworm, Tomato Hornworm, Tomato Pinworm, Vegetable Leafminer, Velvetbean Caterpillar, Western Bean Cutworm, and Whitefly.
