**IMPORTANT: TO AVOID DAMAGE OR POOR RESULTS, CAREFULLY READ ALL DIRECTIONS AND PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS.**

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Shake well before using. Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Exposed food should be covered or removed.

To kill flies, gnats, mosquitoes and small flying moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average size room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects. Before spraying, cover exposed food and utensils.

To kill ants, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, firebrats, sowbugs and spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thoroughly spraying all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas, and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To kill carpet beetles: Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be thoroughly sprayed. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

To kill exposed forms of confused flour beetles, rice weevils and saw-toothed grain beetles: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To kill fleas and ticks in pet bedding and pet areas: Remove and destroy old pet bedding. To reduce infestation, thoroughly spray the animal's sleeping quarters, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, localized areas of floors and other resting places until the surface is slightly moist. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray the entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after spray has dried. DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS. Treat animals with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to re-enter treated areas.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry area, away from heat or open flame.  
**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
